

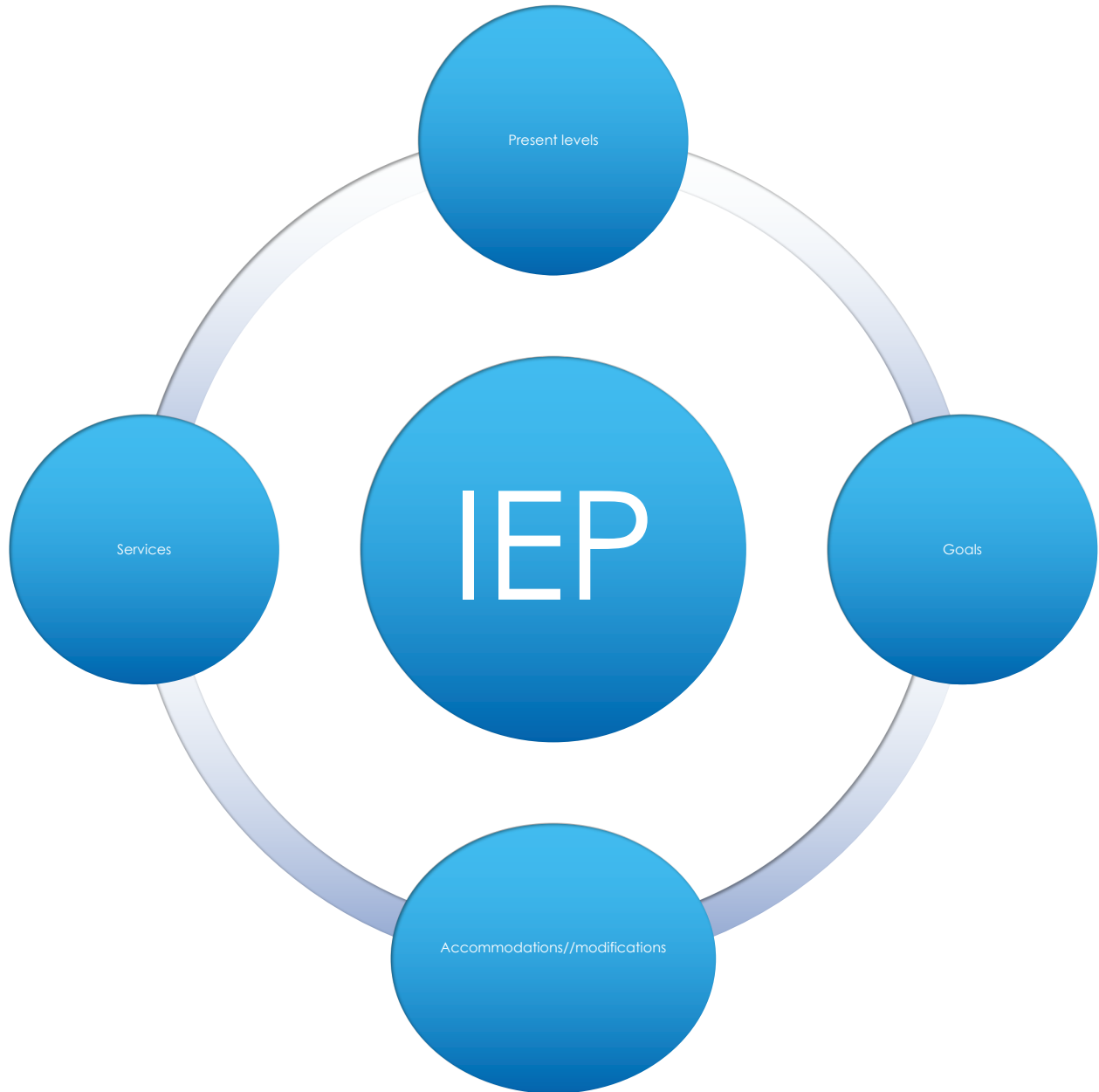


Connecting the Dots
